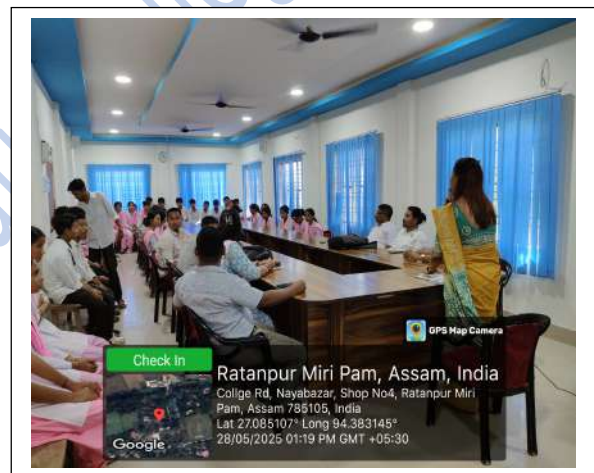

Celebration of Bishnu Prasad Rabha Divas

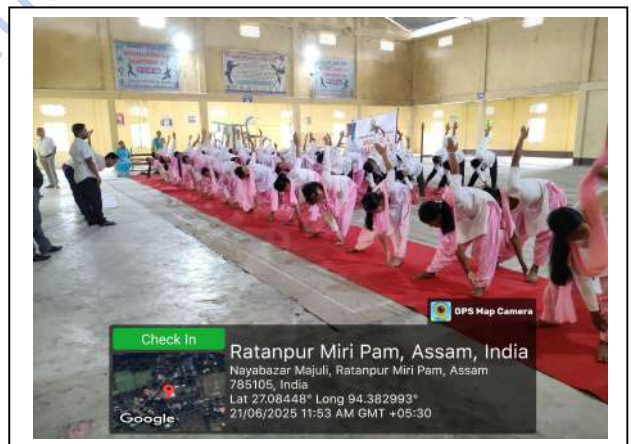

Awareness Programme on “Mental Health Matters”

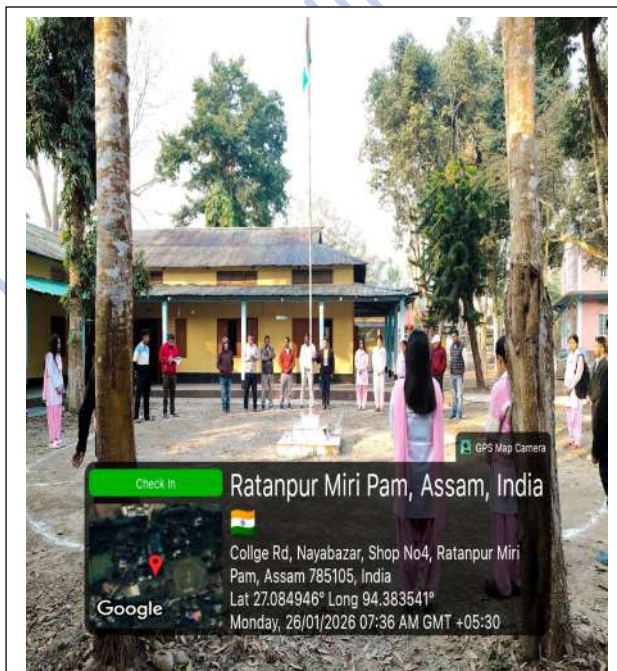
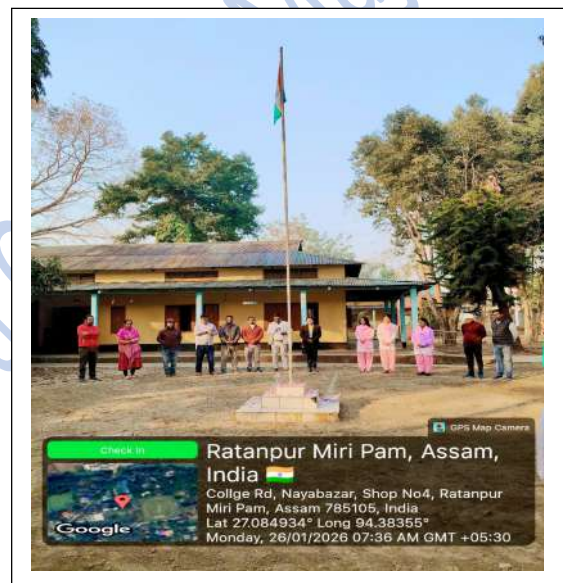
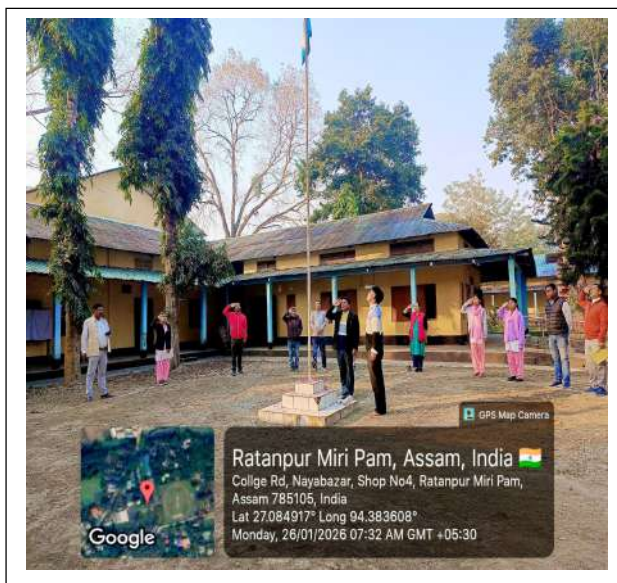

Report on College Week 2025–26

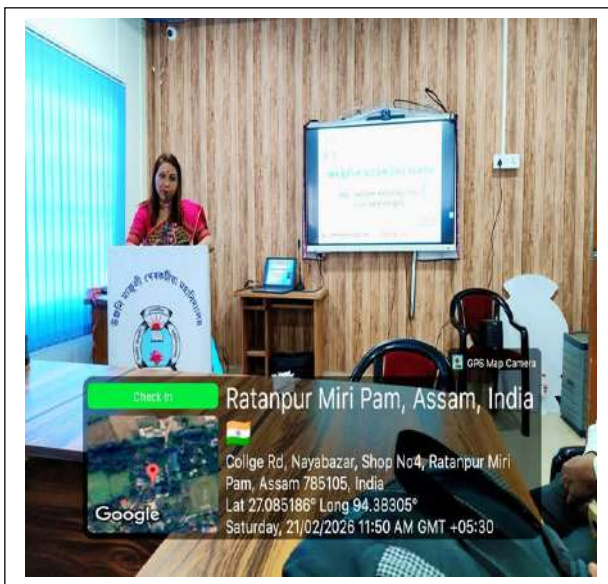

Pre-Bihu celebration

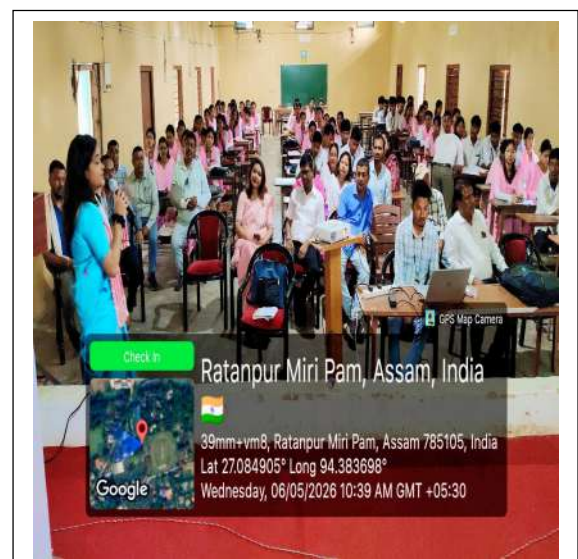
