A one-day workshop on "Issues and Challenges of Higher Education in context of NEP 2020" was organized at Ujani Majuli Kherkatia College on 13th of June, 2023 by the Teachers Unit in collaboration with the IQAC of the college. The Workshop was chaired by the Vice-Principal of the college Mr. Vidhan Kumar and he also delivered the welcome Address. Dr. Binud Borah, Registrar of Majuli University of Culture delivered the key-note address and he explained in details about the philosophy of the NEP 2020, its objectives and opportunities and of course, the obstacles that the colleges might face in implementing the NEP 2020.

Dr. Pranjal Buraguhain discussed in details about the curriculum and courses the Dibrugarh University has framed and the way they are going to be implemented in this year onward. The courses and curriculum will be like:

1. UG Certificate Course-1 year

22+22=44 Credits

If the student wants to exit, he has to complete another 4 credits on Skill/vocational course.

Total credit for one year certificate is total 44+4=48 credits. UGC Norms is 40 credits.

2. UG Diploma Course-2 years

44+44=88 credits

If the student wants to exit, he has to complete another 4 credits on Skill/vocational course.

Total credit for two-year Diploma is 88+4=92 credits. UGC Norms is 80 credits.

3. UG Degree-3 years

88+44=132 Credits' norms is 120 Credits. Provision for both

single Major and double Major.

60 credits for 1st Major and 40 Credits for 2nd Major.



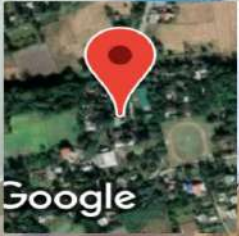

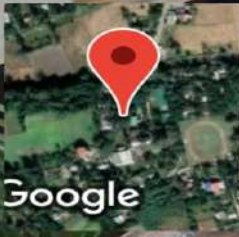
