### A programme on Classical Assamese Language

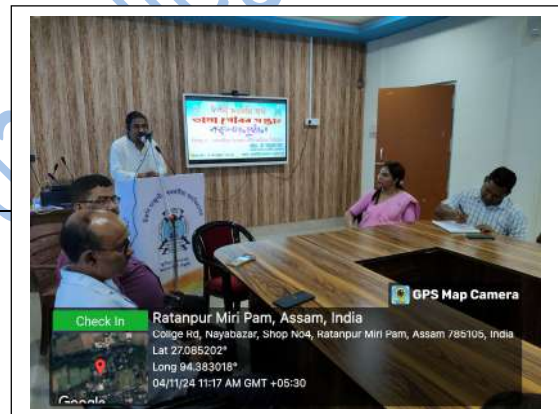
